

Iodine Allergy: Suit Upheld.

The Court of Appeals of Ohio has ruled that it is professional negligence for a visiting registered nurse to apply a dressing containing an iodine preparation when the physician has expressly ordered a plain dressing because the patient has an iodine allergy. Because it is professional treatment, the medical malpractice statute of limitations applies. **Sliger v. Stark Co. Visiting Nurse Service**, 2007 WL 475331 (Ohio App., February 12, 2007).
