he patient had been admitted to the breath, bronchitis and nasal congestion.

He asked for a cup of hot tea. His tea on him. The tea was scalding hot and burned his skin.

of Appeal of Florida was whether this is a case of professional malpractice.

The court found the nurse guilty of hospital with a cough, shortness of ordinary negligence but not guilty of professional malpractice.
